***Dealing With Sins***

**The Scriptural Basis**

**Matt. 5:23** Therefore if you are offering your gift at the altar and there you remember that your brother has something against you, **24** Leave your gift there before the altar, and first go and be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

**2 Cor. 7:1** Therefore since we have these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and of spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

**1 John 1:9** If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

**Prov. 28:13** He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh [them] shall have mercy.

**The Object of our Dealing with Sins**

**1 John 5:17** All unrighteousness is sin,...

**1 John 3:4** Everyone who practices sin practices lawlessness also, and sin is lawlessness.

**Rom. 2:14** For when Gentiles, who have no law, do by nature the things of the law, these, though they have no law, are a law to themselves,

**15** Who show the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience bearing witness with it and their reasonings, one with the other, accusing or even excusing them

**The Basis of our Dealing with Sins**

**1 Tim. 1:19** Holding faith and a good conscience, concerning which some, thrusting these away, have become shipwrecked regarding the faith;

**The Practice of our Dealing with Sins**

**Acts 10:43** To this One all the prophets testify that through His name everyone who believes into Him will receive forgiveness of sins.

**1 John 1:9** If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
